




1. The SHOP SUPEWRVISOR is in charge of technicians in the service facility.

2. The DRIVEABILITY and PERFORMANCE TECHNICIAN tests and adjusts fuel, ignition, and emission systems.



Driveability and Performance Technician




Using a diagnostic analyzer to find the source of engine performance problems

3. An APPRENTICE works under the direction of an experienced technician.

6. A STEERING and SUSPENSION TECHICIAN checks, replaces, and adjusts steering and suspension components.




7. A SPECIALIZED TECHNICIAN is an expert on one system, or one make of a car.

8. A GENERAL TECHNICIAN is an experienced professional who has mastered all specialized areas and can work on any part of a car.




Engine Technician


