Strategies To Increase Reading Comprehension

| 1. | Associating | Associating something familiar with something unfamiliar |
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| 2. | Paraphrasing | Repeating information over again in your own words |
| 3. | Categorizing | Using labels to categorize related words into subgroups |
| 4. | Patterning | Using visual patterns, drawing pictures or patterns |
| 5. | Visualizing | Using visual clues such as picture, letters, numbers or words |
| 6. | Analyzing | Analyzing similarities and differences of items within a category, using meaning of familiar parts to reason out the meaning of unfamiliar parts |
| 7. | Inferring | Figuring out the meaning from context clues |
| 8. | Scaling | Establishing an orderly sequence such as top-to- bottom, start-to-finish, hard-to-soft or first-to-last |
| 9. | Personalizing | Using examples or stories that will link unfamiliar with a familiar experience |
